A detailed report on the extravaganza organized on the sprawling lawns of the University is presented below:



The University held the Convocation on 7 May 2022 at its Old Campus in the Mahindra World City, Jaipur in a celebratory and graceful manner. PRODUCT DEVELOPMENT BY SCHOOL OF MANUFACTURING SKILLS

- The School developed a specimen for conducting the testing of surface roughness and fatigue for JK Lakshmipat University, Jaipur (JKLU). In all, 42 work pieces were manufactured and handed over to JKLU in September 2021.
- The School on the request received from *Jaipur Club Foot Pvt. Ltd.* developed specimens in order to be used by them to aid in the treatment of Club Foot in June 2022.
- The School addressing the request received from Dr. Sonika Saxena, the Vice Principal & Associate Professor, Dr. B. Lal Institute of Biotechnology, Jaipur, developed moulds to make purely organic and eco-friendly organic incense sticks from flower waste. The desired number of parts were manufactured on a 3 axis CNC Milling Machine (Emco Concept Mill 250) with the use of Mastercam in June 2022.

The academic session of the summer semester commenced on 4 October 2021 to welcome the newly admitted students of the Summer Semester batch. INTRODUCTION






NEP gives freedom of choice for skill development: AICTE chief

'Universities in the country should raise academic level, strive for excellence'

The new National Education Policy (NEP) gives more freedom of choice for skill development to the students of vocational courses with its multidisciplinary approach and gives due weightage to all types of skills. All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE) chairman Anil D. Sahasrabudhe said here on Saturday.

Prof. Sahasrabudhe said all universities in the country should raise their academic level and strive for excellence in the true spirit of NEP. "Technical and vocational institutions, by their

very nature, can make dedicated efforts for fostering skill development in the country," he said while addressing the first convocation ceremony of the Bharatiya Skill Development University (BSDU).

Degrees awarded Degrees of bachelor and master of vocational studies as well as doctorate were awarded to 236 students of BSDU on the occasion. A reference was made to the NEP's emphasis on the integration of vocational education into all school and higher education institutions with the identification of fo-

cus areas based on skills gap analysis and mapping of local opportunities.

BSDU president Achintya Choudhary said the university's students had excelled and performed brilliantly in the national skills competi-

tions held in Bengaluru and New Delhi recently. "The BSDU follows the model of education based on the Swiss Dual System of training companies and vocational trade schools.

The speakers at the convocation highlighted the significance of innovations by the vocational institutions in order to find new models and practices and extend the reach of vocational education. The higher education institutions are also adopting different models and setting up incubation centres in partnership with industries to provide more opportunities to their students.
